19b (משנה יא) → 20b (סוף הפרק)

- I. מענה a משנה a gainst a flat top (similar to a pup tent, or leaned against a wall)
  - a. חכמים allow
  - b. ד' אליעזר invalidates
    - This משנה. follows ברייתא ;ר' נתן inverts opinions → one may sleep in a "pup tent" inside a אהל, since it doesn't constitute a separate אהל
    - ii. If: 1 טפח was raised as a roof, valid (הל' סוכה ד:ז)
- II. משנה יאם: use of small and large mats
  - a. ה"ק. a large one
    - i. If: made specifically for lying down, is מקבל טומאה and is invalid for סכך
    - ii. But if: designated for סכך, is not מקבל טומאה and is valid for סכך
  - b. ד"א. large or small,
    - i. If: made specifically for lying down, is מקבל טומאה and is invalid for סכך
    - ii. But if: designated for סכך, is not מקבל טומאה and is valid for סכך
- III. Analysis of the dispute and designation
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> clause: carries inherent contradiction what is the undesignated state?
    - i. Answer #1 (דבא): dispute only about small mat;
      - 1. מתם maintains that an undesignated (סתם) small mat is for lying down
      - 2. מחצלת סתם is for סכך is for מחצלת סתם
      - 3. Challenge (אביי): language is inverted (should be "large or small")
        - a. And: dispute revolves around large mat and א"ז is stringent, rather
    - ii. Answer #2 (פסול → all agree that סתם מחצלת קטנה is for lying down (→ מסול dispute about סתם גדולה
      - 1. ה״ק: if undesignated, used for סכך
      - 2. ד"א if undesignated, used for lying down
        - a. Wording ("if made for lying down"): means "סתם" is considered as if made for lying down")
- IV. Various types of mats
  - a. Mats: made of narrow reeds
    - i. Large: may be used, (not made for sitting)
    - ii. Small: may not be used
  - b. Mats: made of thick reeds
    - i. *If*: braided, may be used (even if small)
    - ii. If: woven, may not be used
    - iii. *ר' ישמעאל ב"ר יוסי.* all may be used (similar to ר' דוסא:)
      - 1. מדרס but not מדרס (i.e. not made for lying) מדרס (i.e. not made for lying)
      - מחצלות::חוצלות :*רשב"ל* 
        - a. טמא and Tiberian mats are not dispute about others, since they're not chiefly made for lying down →not טומאת מדרס or since occasionally used that way →טומאת מדרס
  - c. Contradiction: ר' דוסא rays that mats are מקבל טומאה (→invalid סכך) yet he concurs with ר' ישמעאל ב"ר יוסי
    - i. Resolution: if the mats have an edging, מקבלים טומאה and may not be used
  - d. Reassessing mats: if made of thin or thick reeds or horse-hair (dispute ר' דוסא/חכמים)
    - i. If: חוצלות are bags thin reeds are used for holding fruit, thick reeds for small baskets
    - ii. If: חוצלות are mats thin reeds are used for sieves, thick reeds for covering wine-barrels
  - e. בבל came back from בבל with report that mats may be used
    - i. *ר' יהושע (his uncle)*: concurred, as long as they have not finished/raised edges.
