- I מומים משנה ב of the eye which are considered valid
  - a *The eyelid*: that has a hole, has some piece missing or is cut
  - b The eye: that has a stain (דק) a חלזון-נחש תבלול or diseases; רמב״ם growths)
    - i *תבלול*. white (line/streak) that cuts through the iris into the pupil (cyst of iris)
      - 1 However: if there is a black line/streak that cuts through (coloboma of iris) not a and
        - (a) *Note*: this is per יוסי following v. 1 interprets that the iris is not called "eye", but "fat of the eye"
        - (b) *Contra*: תבלול, who sees both black→white and white→black as תבלול = confuses (מבלבל) the eyes
  - c אום if the דק (stain) is embedded מום; if floating not a מום
    - i *Challenge*: we have a ברייתא that reads the inverse
    - ii *Proposed answer*: one is in the pupil, one in the iris
      - 1 Block: we learned that there are no מומים in the iris
    - iii *Answer*: one is a white stain, the other a black stain
    - 1 Per: מום (as told to רבב"ח) –embedded black stain = מום; floating not a מום; inverse with white
  - d Story (supporting read of חלזון נחש as one ר' יוסי בן לקוניא: אלעזר showed ר' יוחנן בן אלעזר an instance of חלזון נחש
    - i *background*: he was showing him in order to allow it to be slaughtered
      - 1 *and*: even though a man may not inspect מומים of his own animals, he may use them to instruct his students (and show them as examples) and then the students may issue the confirmation
      - 2 *challenge*: such פסקי הלכה must be issued before the practical case comes to the חכם else it is invalid
        - (a) *answer*: in this case, he had issed the ruling beforehand and then found the example in his own flock
- II מומים more מומים in eyes which justify פריון (and, by extension, פריון קדשים)
- a *חוורוד*. white drops in eyes or a steady flow of liquid from eyes
  - b Inspection: must last at least 80 days and (per ארחב"א) must be checked 3 times during 80 days (יב"י) –at even intervals)
  - c *Therapy:* for tearing eyes must eat moist grass followed by dry grass (hay)
  - i *Not*: eating moist & dry together (rain-fed **or** irrigated fields) or dry then moist none of these are therapeutic
  - d *Attribution*: ברייתא, per ברייתא:
    - i *ברייתא* is 40 days; constant dripping 80 days
      - 1 חוורור :*ד' יהודה* is 80 days
      - 2 And (after correction): must eat moist, then dry from rain-fed field; if reverse order or irrigated no מום
      - 3 And: must eat over the course of 3 months
        - (a) Challenge: אלול ותשרי moist grass is אדר וניסן, dry is אלול ותשרי
        - (b) Answer: ראב"א really said that moist is אדר and ½ ניסן; dry is אלול (sum=3 months) תשרי (sum=3 months)
      - 4 *Question*: must the moist be eaten during moist season and dry during dry season?
        - (a) Proposed answer: אלול ותשרי (quoting ר' יצחק בר אשיאן) moist during אלול ותשרי, dry during אלול ותשרי שלא אלול וושרי אדר וניסן
        - (b) *Block*: perhaps he meant the fruit of אדר וניסן but eaten whenever
      - 5 *Question*: how much must he be fed (for this to be a legitimate therapy  $\rightarrow$  test of  $\gamma$ )?
        - (a) *Answer (ר׳ יוחנן*): גרוגרת
          - (i)  $\pi r$  in rrs r they asked if this is at the 1<sup>st</sup> meal of the day or at every feeding time?  $\pi rs r$  (to all)
            - 1. If: at first meal before eating (when it certainly helps like a drug) or afterwards?
            - 2. And: before or after drinking (water)? beforehand certainly helps like eating barley (flush)
            - 3. And: what if it is tied down? If loose, certainly works
            - 4. And: what if alone? If with other animals, certainly will help
            - 5. And: what if out in city? If in field, certainly works
              - a. אשי even if field works, what about a garden near city?
      - 6 Question posed to שמואל what if he doesn't heal with this therapy is the מום now retroactive?
        - (a) Practical difference: is there מעילה on the כספי פדיון used back then?
        - (b) שמואל: couldn't answer applied v. 2
- III משנה דו if the nostrils or moustache are pierced, missing a piece or cut מום which justifies שחיטה which justifies
  - a מום; if the nostrils are cut open to each other; if hole is outside מום; if inside not a מום

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
